

Day 1: Arrival at Serengeti - Check-in & Evening Game Drive

In the evening, enjoy your first game drive in the iconic Serengeti plains, spotting wildlife like lions, elephants, giraffes, and more. Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight stay.






Day 2: Full-Day Game Drive & Wildebeest Migration (Mara River)

After an early breakfast, embark on a thrilling full-day safari adventure through the endless plains of the Serengeti. Today's focus is the **Northern Serengeti**, especially the **Mara River** region—famous for one of nature's greatest spectacles: the **Great Wildebeest Migration**

As you travel through the park, you'll encounter vast herds of wildebeest, zebras, and gazelles in motion, guided by instinct across dangerous terrain in search of fresh grazing. **The Mara River crossing**, if timed right, is an unforgettable scene—thousands of animals braving crocodile-infested waters, with predators like lions and hyenas lurking nearby.

Enjoy a packed bush lunch surrounded by the wild, taking in the sounds and sights of the savannah. Your expert guide will lead you through quieter routes for up-close wildlife encounters. By late afternoon, return to the lodge with unforgettable memories and photos.





Day 3: Game Drive & Transfer to Ngorongoro/Lake Eyasi Region

Begin the day with an **optional early morning game** drive for those wishing to catch the Serengeti's wildlife at its most active. After returning, enjoy breakfast at the lodge, check out, and begin your journey toward **Lake Eyasi** passing through the scenic **Ngorongoro Conservation Area**. The drive offers stunning landscapes and occasional wildlife sightings en route.

Arrive by late afternoon and check in to your lodge near Lake Eyasi, ideally positioned for the next day's cultural visit to the Hadzabe tribe.it will take approximately 5-6 hours to reach lake eyasi. If time permits, you may explore a bit of the lakeside area in the evening.



Day 4: Hadzabe Tribe Experience & Lake Eyasi - Transfer to Arusha

Today offers a rich and immersive cultural encounter. After an early breakfast, visit the **Hadzabe tribe**—one of the last remaining huntergatherer communities in Africa. Experience their traditional way of life, including **hunting with bows and arrows**, making fire by hand, and listening to oral stories passed down generations. You'll also get to hear their distinct **click-based language**, a rare and fascinating part of their identity. Continue to meet the *Datoga tribe*, skilled blacksmiths known for crafting tools and jewelry using traditional methods. Learn about their customs, attire, and way of life.

Later, unwind by Lake Eyasi, enjoying its tranquil views and birdlife. Return to your lodge nearby for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 5: Departure

After breakfast, transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) or Arusha Airport for your return flight. From Lake Eyasi, the journey takes approximately 6 to 7 hours by road, covering around 250–280 km depending on your lodge location and road conditions. You'll leave with unforgettable memories of Africa's wildlife and the rich Hadzabe culture.
